

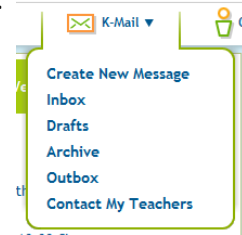
# Middle School Student Daily Checklist

## Log into Your Student Account Through the Online School (OLS)

- See page 3 for the link and fill in your login information

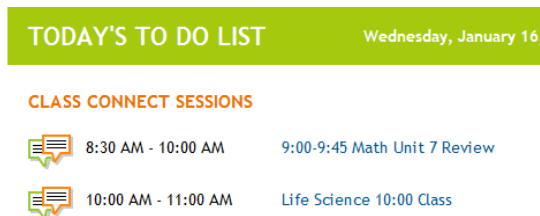
## Check your K-mail at Least Twice per Day

- Look for important notes from teachers, updates, announcements, missing assignment notices, ways to get help, etc. and reply to your teacher if needed.



## Attend all of Your Class Connect Sessions Every Day

- Attend live sessions through the Class Connect links on their OLS home page.
- Please note: Synchronous student attendance is captured through attending live sessions.



## Complete Assignments as Directed by Your Teachers

- Synchronous students will not follow the daily or weekly plan in their OLS.
- Teachers provide specific directions regarding the assignments to be completed each day as well as will make a weekly assignment list available to students on the team website.
- Student daily assignments may include a lesson completed during the live session, a lesson in their OLS course, a quiz, a Study Island Pathway, etc...
- You may be asked to complete assignments through your Google account. See page 3 for the link and your login information
- When in doubt on what assignments to complete for the day check your team's website or K-mail your course teacher.



**REMEMBER:** This doesn't mean you have to do a lesson in class AND a lesson from your daily plan. Pay close attention to your teacher's assignments. You may skip around on the OLS or complete OLS lessons together in class which you can mark as finished.

## Reminders:

- **Take notes during class!** Taking great notes will not only help prepare you for tests, papers and assignments but will allow you to practice writing skills. Well-developed writing skills will be important during and after high school. Have a notebook, pens, pencils, and a calculator readily available as you work throughout the school day.
- The Learning Coach must notify the **Attendance Office** of any student absences. An absence excuse must be K-mailed to the Attendance Office within 3 school days of the absence. After 10 days, a physician's note is required to excuse the absence.
